GROWTH

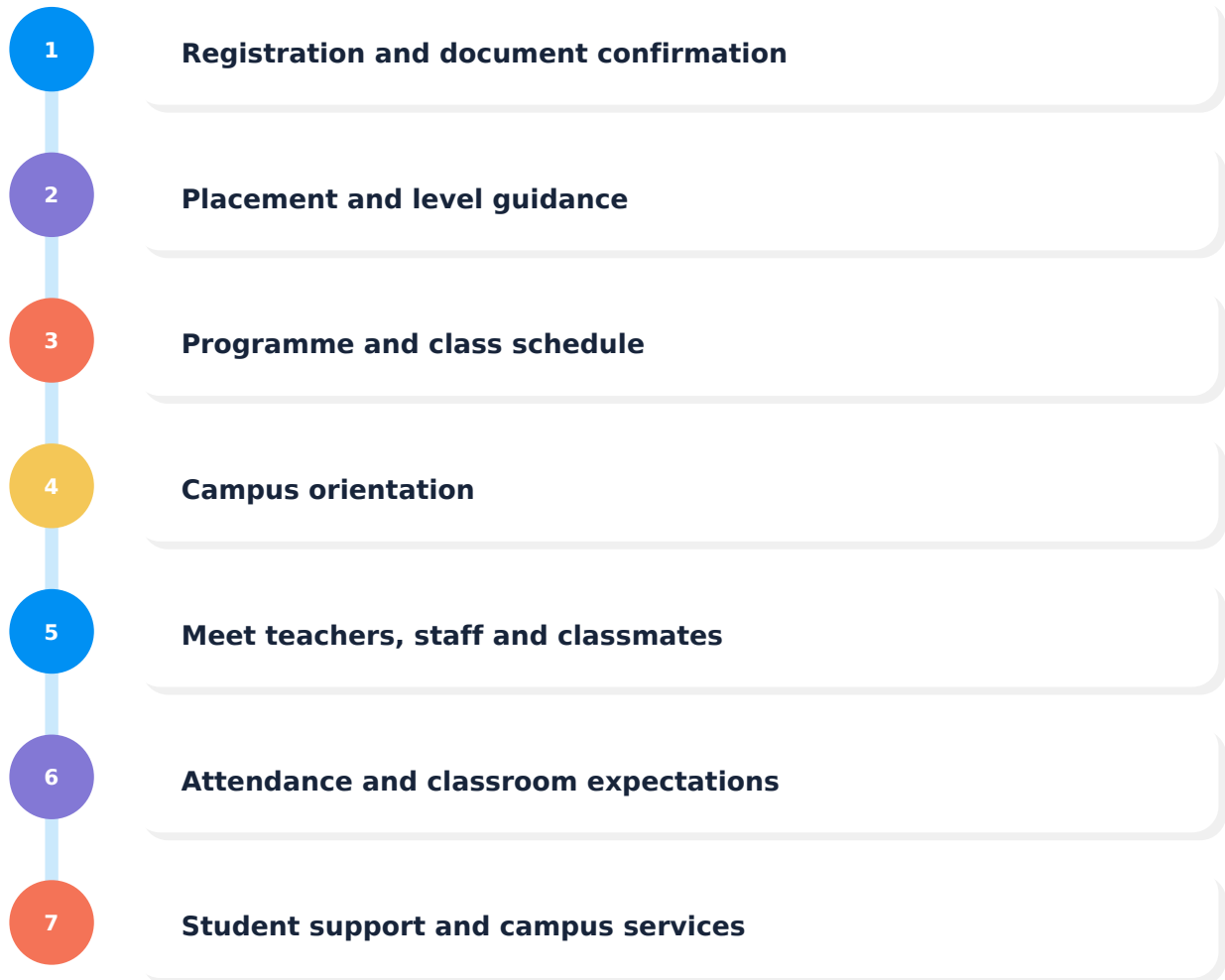
Continuous academic and personal development supported by experienced teachers and caring staff.

If something is affecting your studies or student experience, speak with us early so we can provide appropriate guidance.

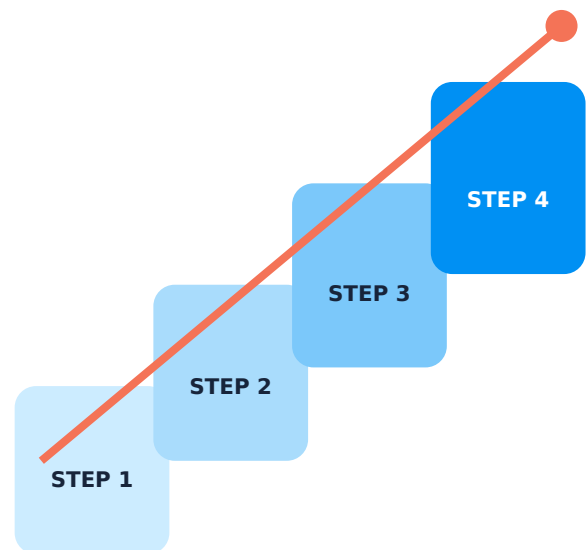
